- 6) What conditions are made using the word "if"? (verses 6, 7, 14 and 15)
- 7) What is the command regarding our "hearts"?
- 8) What are the teaching points about God's ways and His wrath? (vs 10, 11)
- 9) The instruction is to "take heed of what"? (Compare with Heb 2:1)
- 10) List the verses that give evidence of the "trinity".
- 11) What grieved God? For how long?
- 12) What is His "rest"? Whom did He swear would not enter therein?
- 13) In what are we to be confident? How do we "hold fast" to this confidence?
- 14) To what does the "provocation" (or rebellion) refer?
- 15) Which verse basically teaches that "The proof is in the continuance"?
- 16) How important is belief?
- 17) What is meant by "partaker (share in) of Christ"?
- 18) What is meant by "exhort" in verse 13?
- 19) How can Jesus be "a son over His own house"? verse 6
